

***Galation – Chapter 5 – Verse 22*** – But the fruit of the Spirit is

**Love** – deep – tender feeling.

**Joy** – glad feeling; glad behavior.

**Peace** – quiet; calm; stillness.

**Longsuffering** – patient under trouble, pain, or injury.

**Gentleness** – being good – kindness.

**Goodness** – being good – kindness.

**Faith** – trust – believing in God or in gods promises.

**Meekness** – patience under injury trouble; submitting easily to another's will.

**Temperance** – self – control, being moderate in action, speech, habits, etc. against such there is no law.

***Galation – Chapter 5 – Verse 19***

Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these;

**Adultery** – unfaithful of a husband or a wife.

**Fornication** – voluntary sexual intercourse between unmarried persons.

**Uncleanness** – dirty, filthy, impure.

**Lasciviousness** – feeling, lust, showing lust, causing lust.

**Idolatry** – the worship of idols.

**Witchcraft** – magic power.

**Hatred** – very strong dislike, hate.

**Variance** – disagreement.

**Emulations** – imitation in order to equal or excel.

**Wrath** – very great anger – rage.

**Strife** – quarreling – fighting.

**Seditions** – speech or action causing discontent or rebellion.

**Heresies** – a belief different from the accepted belief of the bible.

**Envyings** –discontent or ill will at another good fortune because one wishes it had been his;

**Murders** – the unlawful killing of a human being when it is planned beforehand.

**Drunkness** – condition caused by drinking too much alcoholic liquor.

**Revellings** – take great pleasure; merrymaking; a noisy good time.
