## Make up a Lab

## Lab make up materials are either behind the Physics classroom next door (room 2342) or back in the science resource area (where the science tutor area is periods 1-5).

**Plan A:** Find a Physics students from any one of the Physics classes who has already done the lab and can come up to help you with it or at least get it start (if you do not need two people). This lab can be done yourself.

The make up lab materials are only in the back for about four or five days after the lab is completed and all make up labs are put away the day of the test for any given unit so you just lose the points if you haven't found time to get it done by then.

You may make up the lab any period of the day, before school (I am here at 6:15 am at the latest, usually by 6 am even), or after school (I am here until 6 pm or later on most days).

**Plan B:** Figure out the lab yourself and find a non-physics student, parent, or sibling to aid you (if you'll need help timing or something.)

**Plan C:** Make up the lab periods 1-5 so that the Science Tutor Center teacher can help you with the timing. Mr. Jenkins is 2<sup>nd</sup> period and Mr. Konichek is 4<sup>th</sup> period but any science tutor teacher can help you.

Last Resort: Find out if/when your teacher is available to help you. Note: With the extra period each semester (which cannot be used as a prep) so if we try helping someone during our one prep period we sink otherwise we just keep our heads above water.
