



Then changing it to the Thomas Sewell & Mary Norton branch in 1707-mid to late 1700's again starting from the beginning













Taking another branch (just for 1 page) starting back at Sir Edward Coleman I & Edwina Alice Wyncoll 1505 – 1581




Then the lowest branch for a page, starting back at Robert Cutler 1525 – 1596 & Parnell Barker 1530 - 1595

After following many other branches that dead ended in England I finally followed a branch of Edmund Wright II 1520 – 1584 & Frances Spring 1523 – 1599 back to





William De Franceis who was born in England 1019 but he died in Normandle, France 1071. All William De Franceis paternal family before him for the previous five generations were born in France dating back to 939 Geoffrey DeBolebec. If you check a map of England back then, France was many times the size it is now.

All the branches of John Wright 1450 – 1509 & Lady Agnes Beresford 1454 – 1509 back as far as I could take them all were still in England.


Taking Thomas Spring 1473 – 1523 & Alice Marguaret Appleton 1477 – 1523 back to 1078 – 1114 Alan FitaFlaald Seneschal of Dol came from France to England however two generations before Alan of Dol his ancestry came from North Wales and before that just Wales is where it dead ended.







Edward Beatham 1777 – 1875 & Margaret Crocker 1778 – 1850 ends with just the one page below (all in England)




Another page of Sheridan Miller Dyer 1860- 1947 has them all in Maine, USA yet.






Above. Taking Daniel Dyer 1753 – 1817 back before Maine to Capt. Edward Hutchinson of England.

Then taking Capt. Edward Hutchinson and all those in his generation, IT IS ALL ENGLAND again below shows this






That n de Grey, Knight on the left above is 9 generations after Richard & Elizabeth Hilton above.








Taking Dr. Henry Taylor branch you do end up in France as shown below with apparently a famous French couple shown for next two scenes below






Then going back again to the screen below




Note above that Anthony Stroute & Mary Olyver stops in England three generations earlier.


But taking John Pike back takes you to Italy below




As Aaron John Fitz Rogers goes from Italy to England with his son Aaron Fitz Rogers III who marries Elizabet de Holland who was also born in Italy.







All Samuel Cash & Patience Pike above lower left end in England. One route in 1520, another in 1509 and the above route in 1565.


















This is what I found interesting. Note below where John Fitz Gelbert Marshal above left was born and died and then below that note where his wife was born and died (both blow ups below)




The lowest branch goes back a lot further to the below two screens
