Please read the information on this page to your group before exiting the bus. Thank you!

SIX FLAGS policies have been established for the safety and well being of all our guests, including your group.

If you are going to have your group re-assemble someplace in the Park, please think about picking a location other than the front gate/reflection pond/Columbia Carousel area, as this area becomes extremely crowded and it may be difficult to re-assemble your group.

- Six Flags reserves the right to search all guests entering the property. This is done by an Electronic Metal Detection System at our front gate. ALL bags are also inspected at the front gate. Entry will be denied to those refusing to be searched.
- We want to prevent anything that may be inappropriate from entering the park. If you have anything that could be considered inappropriate you will not be allowed to enter the park with it.
- Smoking is only permitted in DESIGNATED SMOKING AREAS behind the BLUE LINE. All other areas are smoke-free. VIOLATORS will be ejected without refund!
- Remember the following items cannot be brought in to the park:
 - Food, beverages, or alcohol
 - Illegal drugs, laser pointers, or weapons of any kind
- Line jumping, use of profane language, shoplifting, running in the Park, or other disorderly behavior will not be tolerated. **Violators will be escorted out of the Park without refund.**
- Guests do have the option of securing their loose articles in ride lockers or with non-riders. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items such as loose articles of any kind (including purses, backpacks, plush items and beverage containers).
- Great America has a dress code:
 - Shirts and Shoes must be at all times.
 - Clothing with obscene or offensive words or depictions will not be allowed.
- Great America is open until 5 p.m. Six Flags does not have lost parties.
- There is **no re-entry** after 7 p.m.

If you should have questions or need assistance at any time during your day, stop a Security Officer or other park employee, and they will be happy to assist you.
